If you fail to follow test regulations, your test session may be terminated and/or you may be disqualified.






Download the Guardian browser if you have not already done this.



Be prepared to show your room.




Have your valid passport with you.







Do not use assistive software, including Grammarly and predictive text.




You must have only one door behind you.



Only 1 blank sheet of paper and pen/pencil is allowed.






Only water in a clear glass or bottle is allowed.

No sunglasses allowed.




No phones or devices may be used during the test.




No headphones, headsets or ear buds allowed.




Only one 5 minute break, taken between test modules. Inform your proctor via the chatbox. When you return, perform a room pan.
